On the morning of March 27, 2011 just after 0300hrs, PSC received calls reporting a fire in the house at 4711 Oliver St in the first due. Engine 73, Tower 7, and Chief 7 responded with 11 personnel and arrived quickly on the scene with fire showing from the top floor of a 3 story Victorian style home. Engine 73 advanced the preconnect into the building and up to the third floor, while the Tower conducted the primary search, opening up, ladders, and venting. Other units arrived on the scene and performed their assigned duties. The bulk of the fire was knocked in about 15 minutes. With the style of house, there was extensive overhaul opening up the walls from inside and outside. Units from Company 7 worked on the scene for several hours and cleared the scene at 0608hrs.
